Decision

The Leisure, Health and Community Engagement Portfolio Holder, Neighbourhood Services and Community Safety Portfolio Holder, Planning Policy and Economic Development Portfolio Holder, Resources Portfolio Holder and the Street Scene, Parks and Open Spaces Portfolio Holder **agreed**:

- That the proposed fees and charges, as set out in Appendix 1, for the 2025/26 financial year be approved and implemented from 1 April 2025 unless an immediate or other change is indicated.
