- 2. Freedom of Entry to the Borough: The Duke of Lancaster's Regiment**

The Council to consider the following motion:

"That in accordance with Section 249(5) of the Local Government Act 1972, this Council wishes to place on record its high appreciation of, and debt of gratitude to The Duke of Lancaster's Regiment and resolves that the Honorary Freedom of the Borough be conferred on The Duke of Lancaster's Regiment and its successors for all time and that it be granted the right, privilege and honour of marching through the streets of Wyre Borough on ceremonial occasions with swords drawn, bayonets fixed, drums beating, bands playing and colours flying."

(Note: The 1972 Act requires that to confer this honour "a resolution must be passed by no less than two thirds of the Members voting thereon at a meeting of the Council specially convened for this purpose").

The Duke of Lancaster's Regiment will exercise their Freedom of Entry to the Borough by parading through the streets of Poulton-le-Fylde, followed by a Reception at the Civic Centre, or an appropriate alternative location, on a date to be determined but expected to be in September 2018.
