

Record of a decision taken by the Resources Portfolio Holder

Procurement of the GovDelivery Communications Cloud

On 11 January 2018 the Corporate Director Performance and Innovation submitted a report seeking the Resources Portfolio Holder's approval for the joint procurement of the GovDelivery Communications Cloud software provided by Granicus with Fylde Council.

Decision taken

The Resources Portfolio Holder gave his approval to proceed with the joint procurement of the Granicus GovDelivery Communications Cloud platform with Fylde Council and agreed that the Granicus GovDelivery Communication Cloud platform be procured using GCloud under the following exemption to Contract Procedures: "if a framework agreement is available that necessitates the Council not having to go out to tender and the goods, works and services will still provide the Council with best value for money".

When will these decisions be implemented?

If a decision is "called-in", the Overview and Scrutiny Committee may decide that the original decision should be upheld or ask the Portfolio Holder to reconsider the decision.
