Exclusion of Public and Press 5.

In accordance with Paragraph 11 of the Access to Information Rules in Part 4 of the Council's Constitution, the Chief Executive has determined that the reports submitted under items 6 and 7 of this agenda are "Not for Publication" because they contain "exempt information", as defined in Schedule 12A of the Local Government Act 1972.

If the Committee agrees that the public and press should be excluded for those items, it will need to pass the following resolution:-

"That the public and press be excluded from the meeting whilst agenda items 6 and 7 are being considered, because they refer to exempt information as defined in category 1 (information relating to any individual) of Part 1 of Schedule 12(a) of the Local Government Act, 1972, as amended by the Local Government (Access to Information) Variation Order 2006 and, that the public interest in maintaining the

exemptions outweighs the public interest in disclosing the information."

The Committee is asked to note that it is proposed that the public and press also be excluded whilst agenda item 6 is considered under regulation 14(2) of the Licensing Act 2003 (Hearings) Regulations 2005 (Statutory Instrument No 44 because it is considered that the public interest in the hearing being held in public is outweighed by the public interest in excluding them, because of the nature of the allegations being made.
