Proposed Increase to Fee for Bronze Vases 2017/18

1. Purpose of report

1.1 To propose a change to the fees and charges for bronze vases at Fleetwood Cemetery due to an increase in external supplier costs.

2. Outcomes

2.1 To cover council costs associated with the increase in external supplier costs.

3. Recommendation

3.1 That the fees and charges for bronze vases for the columbarium are increased from £30 to £44 with immediate effect.

4. Background

4.1 Fees and charges for products are influenced by external suppliers' charges to the council. Alternatives have been investigated but owing to the specific size and fittings of the vases to the columbariums the existing supplier is the only appropriate provider.

5. Key issues and proposals

5.1 Owing to an unexpected price increase from the supplier there is a need to review the council's fees and charges to enable the costs of the increase to be recovered. It is therefore recommended that the fee for a bronze vase increases from £30 to £44.

6. Delegated functions

6.1 The matters referred to in this report are considered under the following executive function delegated to the Leisure and Culture Portfolio Holder (as set out in Part 3 of the council's constitution): To determine charges or fees for any relevant services operated within the Portfolio.

No additional income will be generated as the council does not seek to generate a surplus on the provision of cemetery services.
