Roofing Works to Fleetwood Leisure Centre

1. Purpose of report

1.1 To seek approval to carry out roofing works to flat roofs over the Fleetwood Leisure Centre building and to include the scheme in the Council's 2018/19 Capital Programme.

2. Outcomes

2.1 To deliver the Asset Management programme of works to maximise the return from our assets.

3. Recommendations

- **3.1** That approval is given to carry out necessary roofing works to the flat roofs at Fleetwood Leisure Centre.
- **3.2** That the roofing works costing £157,318 are added to the Council's 2018/19 Capital Programme.

4. Background

4.1 The flat roofs over the Fleetwood YMCA building are almost forty years old and are well past their expected lifespan having been continually exposed to high winds and aggressive environmental conditions. The roof coverings have perished and deteriorated resulting in water ingress in a number of areas into the building. There is also evidence that water has been able to collect under the felt on some sections of the roof saturating the roof insulation.

5. Key issues and proposals

- **5.1** It is proposed to improve the water tightness of the building with an application of the Belzona liquid applied roofing system.
- **5.2** Belzona products have been successfully used on other council buildings. The manufacturer provides a 25 year warranty if the system is applied by a Belzona approved contractor.
- **5.3** Some areas of the roof have skylights; these will be repaired or in some areas removed and roofed over to reduce the potential for leaks in the future. All drainage outlets will be checked and where the covers are missing these will be replaced to prevent blockages.
- **5.4** Following a successful tender exercise via the Chest procurement portal, a Belzona approved contractor has been selected to undertake the roofing works at a cost of £157,318 plus VAT.

6.1 The matters referred to in this report are considered under the following executive function delegated to the Resources Portfolio Holder (as set out in Part 3 of the council's constitution): "To consider the management, repair, maintenance and use of the Council's land and buildings"
