Procurement of ICT technical skills licence

The Service Director Performance and Innovation submitted a report seeking approval for the procurement of an ICT technical skills licence, costing £18,000, with the UK's leading ICT training provider QA to meet all the ICT technical training requirements up to April 2020.

Decision taken

The portfolio holder gave approval to procure the QA ICT technical skills licence via the G-Cloud 10 Procurement Framework, under the exemptions to contract procedures contained within the Financial Regulations and Financial Procedure Rules. This is on the grounds that exemptions are permitted to contract procedures where a framework is available that necessitates the council not having to go out to tender, and the goods, works and services will still provide the council with best value for money.

When will these decisions be implemented?

All decisions will be put into effect five working days from the date of publication, unless a decision is "called-in" by any three members of the council within that period. If a decision is "called-in", the Overview and Scrutiny Committee may decide that the original decision should be upheld or ask the Portfolio Holder to reconsider the decision.
