Overview and Scrutiny Work Programme 2017/18 – update report

1. Recommendations

2. Current and completed work

2.1 <u>Life in Wyre Resident Survey task group</u>

The Life in Wyre Resident Survey task group has completed its work and the draft report was considered by the committee under another item on this agenda. It is anticipated that the task group will report to the Cabinet on 29 November 2017.

2.2 Digital transformation task group

This task group has met twice. It is focusing much of its attention on the proposed introduction of a new committee management system which is likely to enable meetings to become paperless.

The task group will be sending representatives to meetings held in three neighbouring councils during November (Blackpool, Chorley and Fylde). Councillors will be able to observe two different committee management systems and speak directly to other members about their experiences, both positive and negative, of the implementation.

2.3 Engaging with children and young people

The task group that is looking at how the council might engage more effectively with children and young people has met once and will meet for a second time on Tuesday 7 November.

3. Future task group work

- 3.1 The committee has requested that a report about how the council can maximise income from its assets be submitted to the meeting on 8 January 2018. It is intended that this report will provide some guidance on how a related scrutiny task group review should be focused, that review to take place between January and April 2018.
- **3.2** Further proposals for committee agenda items or for task group review topics are invited from councillors at any time.

4. Overview and Scrutiny Committee dates

- 4.1 The original Council Calendar of Meetings included Overview and Scrutiny Committee meetings on both 11 December 2017 and 8 January 2018. Taking into account the closure of the council's offices for a ten-day period over Christmas and New Year it has been agreed that the December meeting of the committee be cancelled and all scheduled business moved to the meeting on 8 January 2018.
- **4.2** The Calendar of Meetings for 2018/19 takes this change into account, no meeting being scheduled between 26 November 2018 and 7 January 2019.
